On the 25th of May 2011 took place First French Youth & Teenagers Internet Governance Forum at the Council of Europe, Strasbourg (France). Participants and active actors of the meeting were young people from French colleges, a number of them situated in socially difficult areas, aged from 13 to 16 years old. The issues discussed by Young people from the multistakeholder perspective were:

- Rights and responsibilities on the Internet and Internet safety
- Copyright
- Use of ICT during school time

The meeting resulted in formulating a message to Information Society leaders that will be presented as a video clip during IGF 2011 in Nairobi (Workshop 126, Wednesday 28 September 2011, 09:00-10:30, Conference Room #13).
