Context

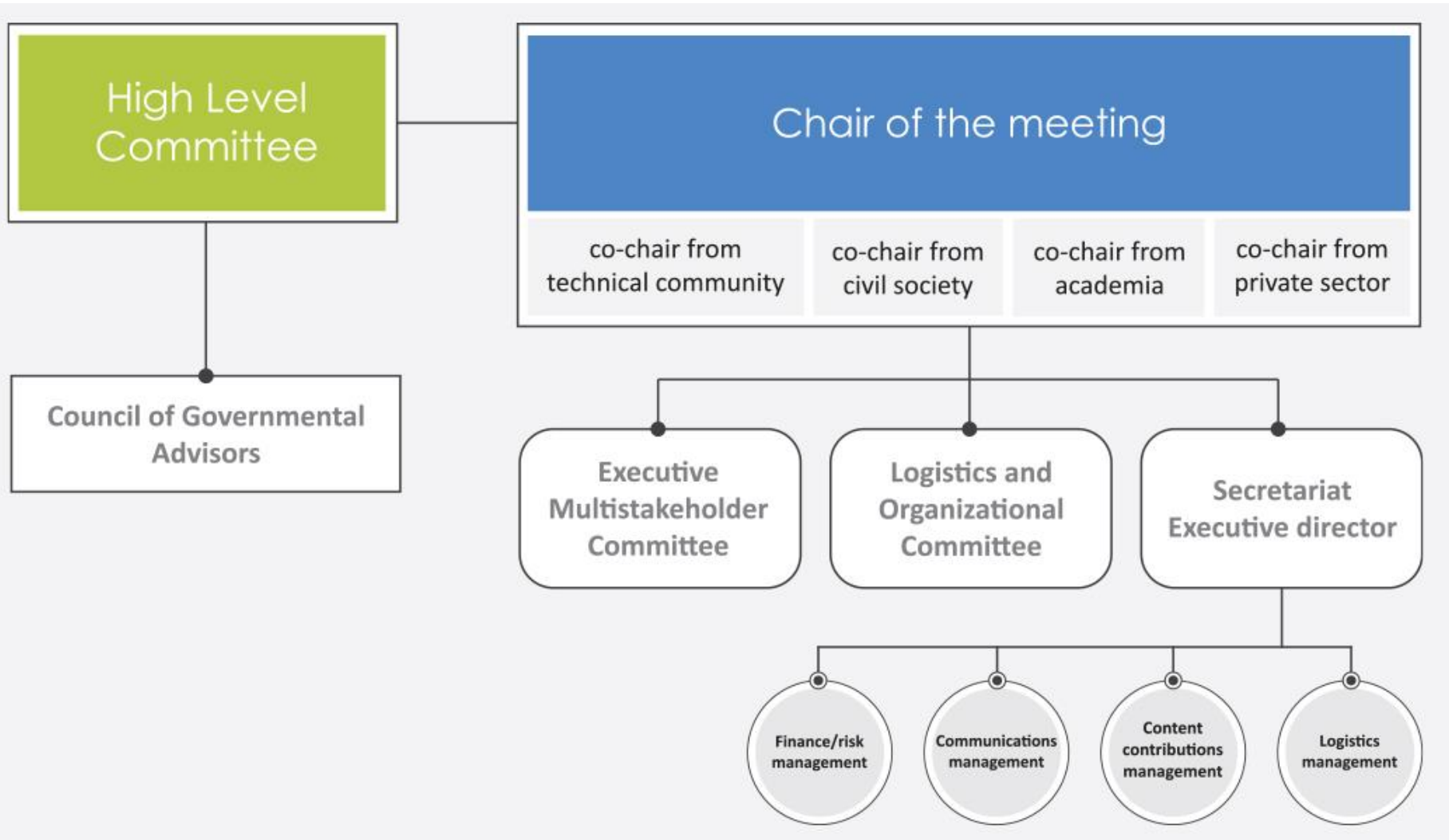
- President Dilma Rousseff's speech at the United Nations (September 24th, 2013). She presented **proposals** for **governance and use of the Internet**, such as freedom of expression, privacy of the individual and respect for human rights, as well as the construction of inclusive and non-discriminatory societies.
- Meeting between President Dilma and Fadi Chehade (ICANN), where they addressed the opportunity to discuss proposals on Internet governance, which led to the Brazilian initiative to host the **Global Multistakeholder Meeting on the Future of Internet Governance**.
- The meeting is being organized in a partnership between CGI.br and international entities representing the different sectors involved with Internet governance (1/Net and others)

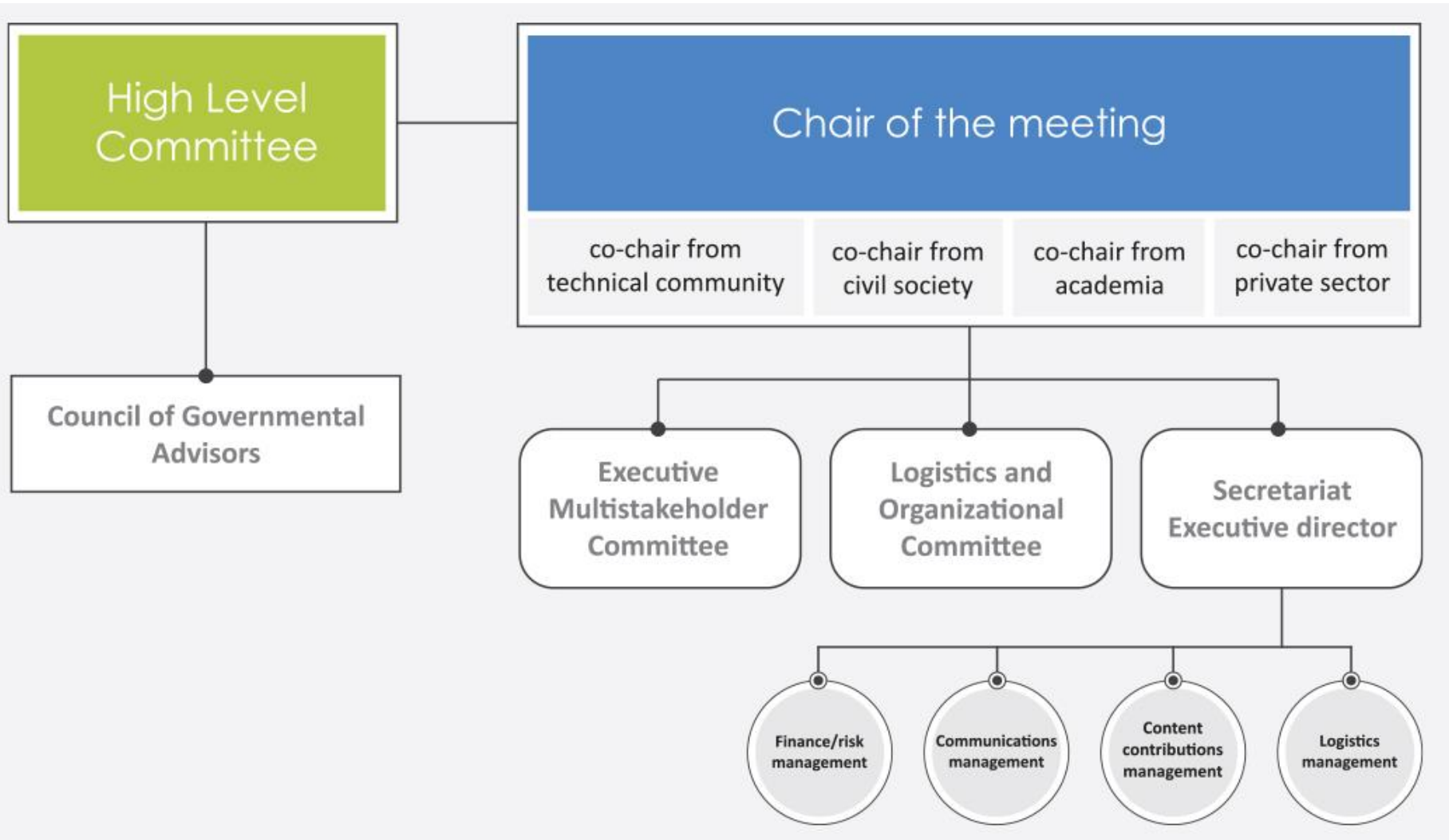

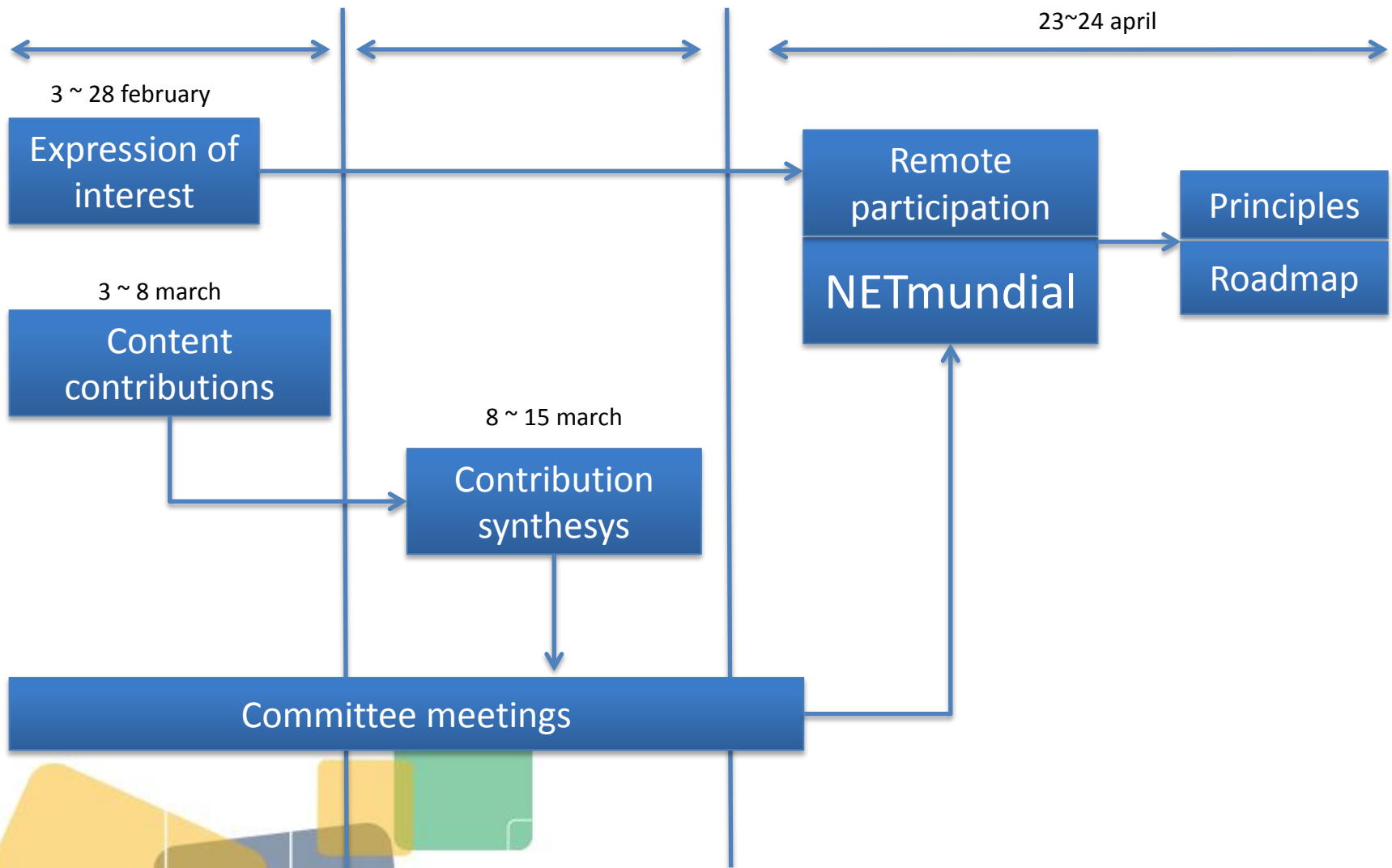
Multistakeholder Meeting: role of the HLMC

- During the meeting, the HLMC and the Chairs of NetMundial will seek approval for the final documents.

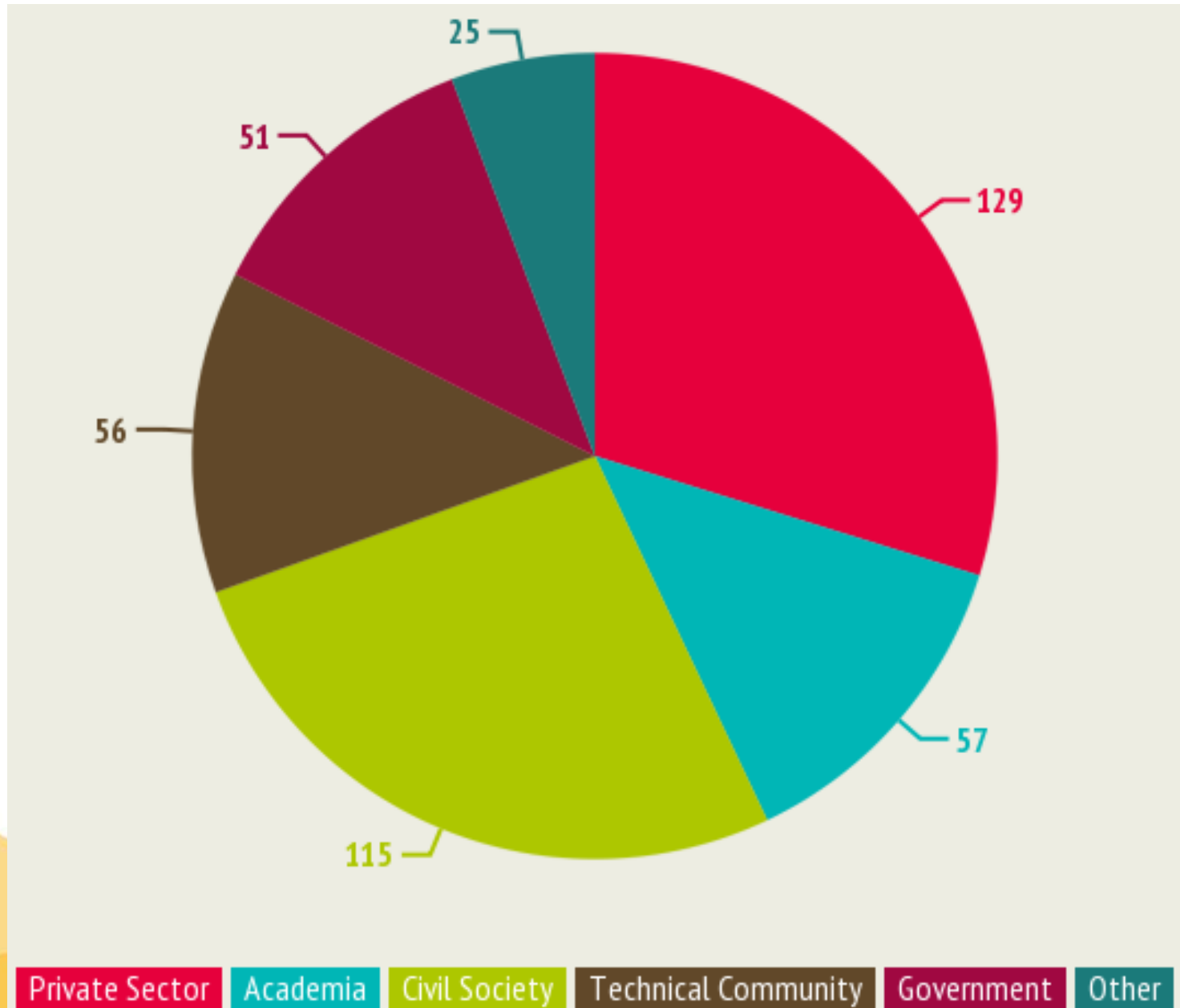

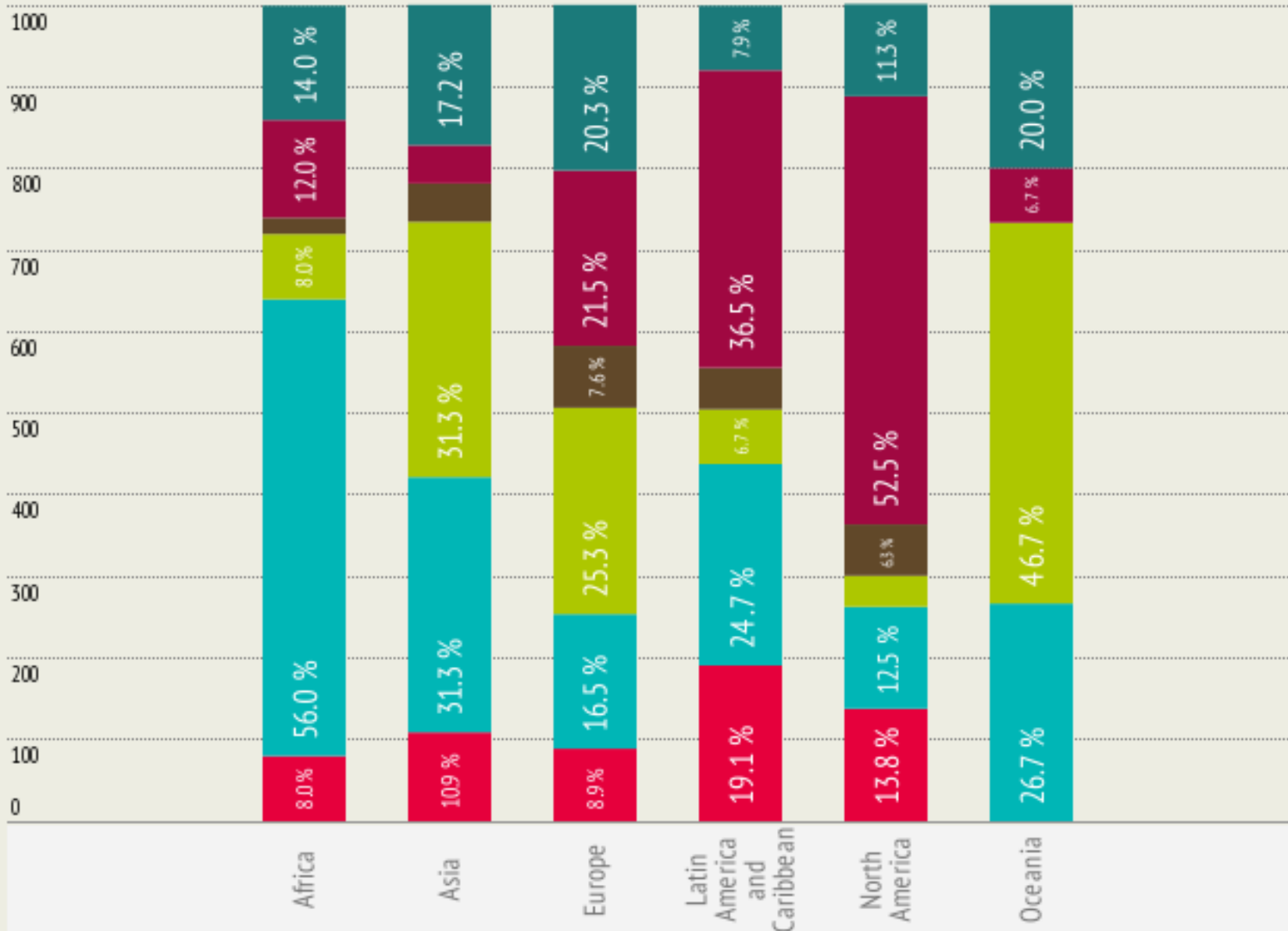
